

STANDARDS FOR JFGP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Nominating Committee should consider the following standards when considering a Trustee:

1. Trustees are our ambassadors for the Federation and the Jewish community. Serving as an ambassador includes speaking to other community members about the value of a strong Federation.
2. Trustees play a proactive role in the organization. This means attending at least 50% of board meetings and major community events. Please note that there are 4 meetings of the Trustees per year. In addition, Trustees are encouraged to actively serve on or lead a Federation committee.
3. Trustees should actively participate as salespeople for the organization including working in the campaign and opening doors for Federation's professional staff and volunteer leadership.
4. Trustees are expected to make Federation a philanthropic priority. A suggested minimum annual gift for those who are

nominated to be Trustees is \$5,000. Exceptions are made from time to time to ensure representation from constituencies that might not otherwise be represented.

Federation's by-laws 4.01 empower the Board of Trustees to:

- Approve Federation's budget
- Approve Federation's allocations
- Elect Officers and Trustees
- Resolve major policy issues referred by the Board of Directors
- Explore and provide direction for dealing with major community concerns
- Approve long range plans for the Federation
- Amend Federation's by-laws
